In order to be considered for selection as a Georgia Scholar, ALL CRITERIA MUST BE MET:

CRITERION ONE: Earn at least 22 Carnegie Units of credit for graduation.

CRITERION TWO: Minimum score of 1360 on the SAT *at one test administration* on the critical reading and mathematical reasoning skills sections or a composite score of 31 *at one test administration* on the ACT.

CRITERION THREE: non-weighted GPA of at least 3.75 on a 4.0 scale, where A = 4, B = 3, C = 2, and D = 1 *in core courses*.

CRITERION FOUR: Registered to vote if a United States citizen and 18 years of age on or before March 3, 2008.

CRITERION FIVE: Evidence of self-esteem and concern for others in day-to-day activities.

CRITERION SIX: Participation *in at least three (3) different* competitive interscholastic activities (e.g., athletics, music, and literary events, fairs, and exhibits).

CRITERION SEVEN: Appointed by school official or elected to positions of leadership in *a minimum of two (2) different* activities sponsored by the school.

CRITERION EIGHT: Evidence of leadership in *a minimum of two (2) different* youth activities outside the school.

Documentation must be provided for each criteria listed above. Applications can be picked up in the Counseling Office or on the school's website, www.northviewhigh.com. Completed applications are due to Mrs. Cole by Monday, February 4, 2008.
